CAPRI

From Marina Grande you will reach Piazza Umberto I (*aka* The Small Square), by minibus.

Capri is one of the most sought-after destinations by tourists from all over the world. The guided tour continues along the winding alleys and splendid terraces with a breath-taking vista of the Faraglioni and Marina Piccola.



An additional stop will be at the Augustus Gardens, with a wonderful series of flowered terraces overlooking the sea, facing the Faraglioni on one side, the Bay of Marina Piccola and the hairpin bends of Via Krupp on the other.

FRIDAY, APRIL THE 26TH

POMPEI

Pompeii, along with Herculaneum and many villas in the surrounding area (e.g. at Boscoreale, Stabiae), was buried under 4 to 6 m (13 to 20 ft) of volcanic ash and pumice in the Eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD.

Largely preserved under the ash, the excavated city offers a unique snapshot of Roman life, frozen at the moment it was buried



Pompeii is a [UNESCO World Heritage Site](#) and is one of the most popular tourist attractions in Italy, with approximately 2.5 million visitors annually

REGGIA DI CASERTA

The Italian "twin sister" of the Versailles Palace, the Royal Palace of Caserta (Reggia di Caserta) is a former royal residence in Caserta, southern Italy, constructed by the House of Bourbon-Two Sicilies, as their main residence as kings of Naples.



It is the largest palace erected in Europe during the 18th century.



In 1997, the marvelous palace – a genuine masterpiece - was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

AGROPOLI AND CASTELLABATE

Castellabate SA, Italy – about 25 Kms from Paestum



The Cilento Coast is one of Campania's most beautiful yet remote corners and still relatively undiscovered.

The area is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site due to its importance on the trade route in the Middle Ages.

From this medieval town there is an amazing viewpoint where you can admire the entire Gulf of Salerno with the Amalfi Coast and in the background also the island of Capri

There are breathtaking views of the countryside, sandy beaches and turquoise waters that surround it.

Wander through the arches and passageways of this village, to the enclosed square at its heart.

Agropoli SA, Italy – about 15 Kms from Paestum

Agropoli is a charming village dating back to the fifth century AD. It is said that Agropoli is the perfect mix of history, nature and Italian hospitality.

The crowning jewel of this historical village is the Saracen castle which was built by the Byzantines.

From the castle are breathtaking views allowing one to imagine how this vantage point became a key defense structure against the Goth invaders of that time.

As these castles lost their strategic importance over time, Italian hillside villages have reinvented themselves.

Agropoli is one of the finest examples of the marriage of time periods. A unique fact about Agropoli is that the original city surrounding the hillside fortress is still inhabited.

With the good beaches nearby, a significant renaissance has taken place.

It is an exciting sequence of must-see places from the castle down to the sea with the beautiful promenade leading to the marina and endless shoreline.
